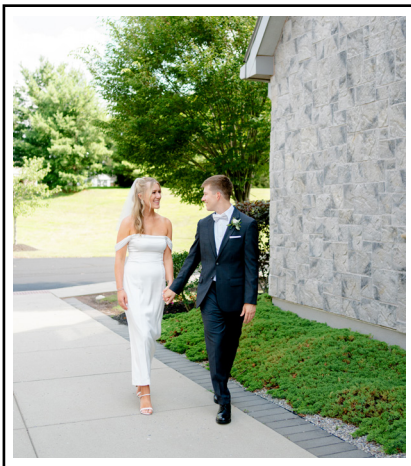

## *Getting Ready*

The morning of your wedding day is filled with anticipation and excitement. This time often includes capturing your thoughtful details - the dress, rings, invitations, and heirlooms - along with the genuine moments shared between you and your closest friends and family before the celebration begins.

## *Ceremony*

The ceremony is the heart of your wedding day. From the walk down the aisle to the exchange of vows and your first kiss as newlyweds, these moments are documented with care while also capturing the reactions and emotions of the loved ones surrounding you.

## *Reception Details & Guests*

Before the reception begins, we often capture the details that bring your celebration together - the reception space, florals, table settings, and other thoughtful elements - along with guests mingling and enjoying cocktail hour.

## *Dinner & Dancing*

The dance floor fills, laughter grows louder, and we capture the candid moments of friends and family celebrating together.

## *First Look / Private Vows*

Some couples choose to share a private moment to see each other, take a breath, and soak in the excitement of the day. This can also be a beautiful time to exchange personal vows in a more intimate setting before the celebration begins.

## *Family & Wedding Party Portraits*

After the ceremony, we typically take time for family portraits, wedding party photos, and relaxed newlywed portraits.

## *Grand Entrance & First Dances*

As the reception begins, the energy of the day shifts into celebration. Moments like your grand entrance, first dance, parent dances, and heartfelt toasts are documented as the evening unfolds.

## *Grand Exit*

Some couples love ending the night with a grand exit - sparklers, confetti, or a special send-off surrounded by friends and family. Because these moments take place later in the evening, extended coverage is often needed. The Luxe Collection allows space to capture the full story of your wedding day from beginning to end.

# THE FIRST LOOK

One decision couples often consider while planning their timeline is whether to include a First Look. A First Look is a private moment where the two of you see each other before the ceremony, usually set aside in a quiet location so you can share the moment without an audience. There is no right or wrong choice. It simply depends on what feels most meaningful to you and how you want to experience your wedding day.

Including a First Look can offer a quiet pause together before the pace of the day picks up. Wedding days often move quickly, and this moment can provide a chance to connect and settle into the day before the ceremony begins.

It can also create more flexibility within the timeline. Because you have already seen each other, some portraits, such as couple photos and wedding party photos, can be completed beforehand. This can reduce the amount of photography needed after the ceremony and may allow for more time with guests during cocktail hour.

Ultimately, the choice is entirely personal. Some couples love the anticipation of seeing each other for the first time during the ceremony, while others appreciate the private experience of a First Look earlier in the day. Both options are meaningful, and the best choice is the one that feels right for you.
